There is a constant need for restoration work, which has to be carried out to a high standard. Preservation and enhancement of this Grade 1 listed building has to be maintained and adapted for the requirements of our future generations.

In the recent past the Church Roof has been re-tiled and a new Main Porch Doorway added at a cost of many thousands of pounds. The PCC will now require help for future repairs and upkeep of the fabric of the Church- building and Church-yard.

The Friends of St Michaels was formed to help with the future cost of maintaining our lovely Church.

St Michaels has a warm and friendly atmosphere, a legacy from centuries of prayer and devotion. Please will you help us by becoming a Friend of St Michaels Church and becoming a Custodian of this historic building?

Membership offers the opportunity to contribute to this work. All funds collected by membership, donations, and associated gift-aid will be separate Restricted Funds. They will be used by the PCC solely for the upkeep of the fabric and maintenance of the Church and Church-yard.

ABOUT St MICHAELS

Our Church is built on one of the oldest foundations in Lancashire, which was proven by the finding of a piece of Anglo Saxon Cross dated circa 850 AD, which was carved from stone from Clieves Hills.

The stone Church as we see it to-day, is a mixture of architectural styles, originally built by the Normans early in the 12th Century and expanded and developed over the centuries according to the needs of the congregation. The work has been carried out over the historical periods of the Early English, Tudor, and Victorian eras to-date.

The Tower was added in the 14th Century and four bells were cast in 1715, with two more treble bells added in 1938. The Bells are rung by our ever growing group of Ringers at Morning Services on Sundays, and at Wedding Services.

The large stone Font situated at the base of the Bell tower also dates to 14th Century; its use has been taken over by a modern portable wooden font which is used for Baptisms, by arrangement, on the last Sunday of the month.

Support for the Chancel roof is now assisted by eight Stone Angels which replaced the twelve wooden Medieval ones, some of which can still be seen at the base of the Bell Tower.

The Congregation comes from Aughton and surrounding areas, to attend a wide variety of informal, contemporary, all-age Family, and special seasonal Services.
